03/14/2022	We have not met our Interim and end targets for math proficiency at Plymouth Scholars. The Interim measure hoped to increase our common assessment scores by 21%. This would be an increase to 80% proficiency. We are currently at 60% proficiency. We do not have data from MSTEP testing. The end target measure would be an increase in proficiency of 3% of Math NWEA. Fall testing shows proficiency rates staying the same as last year (80%). Spring testing will be a better indicator. 03/14/2022	Based on the data, Plymouth Scholars should maintain the math goal of 80% proficiency on Common Assessments and MSTEP. On the Common Assessment Interim 2 reports, it shows our scholars are at 60% proficiency. On the MSTEP 2021 Spring scores, it shows our students are at 69% proficiency. We need to continue focusing on small group instruction and implementation of Dreambox to raise the proficiency rate. Teachers share best practices monthly in wing meetings, evident through agendas.
